To Whom It May Concern:

On February 28, 2006, AstraZeneca submitted a report of payments it made in calendar year 2005 to practitioners in the state of Minnesota. The information contained in that report was based on AstraZeneca's good faith interpretation of, and compliance with, the Minnesota statutes, sections 151.461 and 151.47(f). That report was assembled through a manual process of extracting data from various systems. Despite the diligence that AstraZeneca applied throughout that process, we recently discovered that information contained in that submission was incomplete in some respects and inaccurate in others. Improvements instituted in our data collection process have now enabled more comprehensive reporting, and I am therefore enclosing a supplemental 2005 Disclosure Report correcting the significant discrepancies we identified.

The enclosure is intended to supercede our earlier submission for 2005 with respect to the seven individual practitioners identified. For your convenience, the enclosure contains, for each listed practitioner, both the original reported payment (from the February 28, 2006 submission) and the corrected payment amount as re-submitted today. The enclosure reflects the best information currently available, but is still subject to the challenges associated with the manual nature of the data-collection process.
