Re: State of Minnesota Payments to Practitioners Reporting Form – 2007

Enclosed please find the above 2007 annual filing for Procter & Gamble Pharmaceuticals, Inc. (“P&GP”) identifying certain payments made to Minnesota practitioners. These payments include honoraria and expenses for speaking, payment for research consultation, and meals.

In 2007, P&GP inadvertently paid for meals for nine Minnesota practitioners in excess of the \$50.00 gift limit. The expenditures ranged from approximately \$0.38 to \$43.00, and in some cases were attributable to meals that took place outside of Minnesota. P&GP interacts annually with approximately 1,400 practitioners in Minnesota. These nine practitioners represent only 0.64% of this total.

P&GP takes its responsibilities seriously and we are trying to adapt our processes to avoid even these minor deviations from our policy.
